TMBS SHARED PLACEMENT OFFER 2025

(38 PLACES AVAILABLE - 14 AT KS1 AND 24 AT KS2)

Conditions of placement include:

- 40%/60% shared placement
- No permanent exclusion
- Purchase Inclusion Support Visit from TMBS
- Preparation for return to school by carrying out recommendations

40%/60% PLACEMENT

4 MORNINGS OR 4 AFTERNOONS AT TMBS

4 MORNINGS OR 4 AFTERNOONS PLUS A FULL DAY IN MAINSTREAM ON WEDNESDAYS

BASELINE AND REVIEW ASSESSMENTS = FULL EDUCATION REPORT SHARED AT EDUCATION REVIEW (16 WEEKS)

EDUCATION REVIEW AT 16 WEEKS

Directly Commissioned 8 week placement, following a 20 week TMBSS Primary Shared Placement

The directly commissioned 8 week placement will be subject to the following:

- At the 16 week TMBSS Education Review the date that the 20 week free placement will end will be shared and minuted.
- The date the Directly Commissioned 8 week placement will end will also be shared and minuted.
- The decision to extend the placement by directly commissioning an additional 8 weeks will be recorded in the TMBSS Education Review minutes and will form the contract.
- These minutes will be shared with the mainstream setting and parents.
- The placement is £270 a week, for 8 weeks, totalling £2160. This cost is regardless of the number of sessions the student attends.
- TMBSS will invoice you directly and ask that payment is made before the 8 week extension commences.
- If for any reason the placement ends earlier than the agreed 8 weeks TMBSS will refund the difference.
- The placement cannot be extended further than the 8 weeks under the current LA offer.
- Following the end of the 20 week free placement the LA transport will cease. It is then the responsibility of the mainstream school to source and fund the transport for the student to attend their 60/40 placement for the additional 8 weeks. The LA transport team are able to provide a list of operators on their approved framework if required.
- If the school would like a review meeting during the 8 week extended placement it would be their responsibility to arrange and minute this so the outcomes are shared with all parties.
- If the Senior Leadership Team feel that TMBSS is not meeting the needs of the young person, we reserve the right to end the placement early and a refund will be actioned.
